I know there are lots of opportunity quilts out there. Our tickets are BLUE. I have had a couple of people try to turn in green tickets. I think those are for VQG.

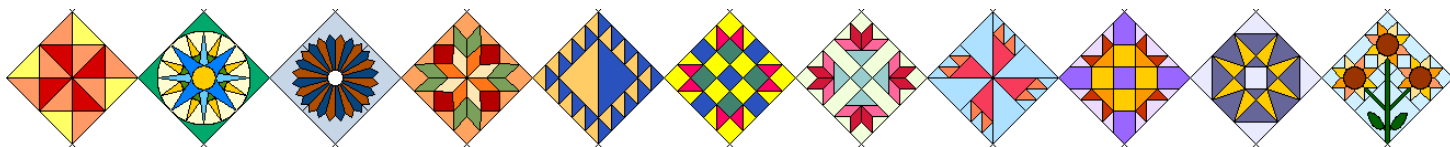

Due September 2017

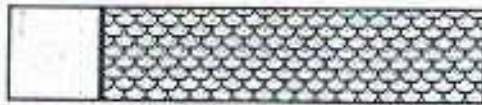
NICE 'n EASY

For each block that will finish 8" x 10"

Four different prints or tone-on-tones (no solids) in bright, cheerful, colors - cut strips  $2\frac{1}{2}" \times 8\frac{1}{2}"$

A white-on-white (no creams, beiges, etc) - cut four squares  $2\frac{1}{2}" \times 2\frac{1}{2}"$

Sew one  $2\frac{1}{2}"$  square to the end of one  $2\frac{1}{2}" \times 8\frac{1}{2}"$  strip. Press toward the print.



Sew two units together along the long edge, with the small squares at opposite ends.  
Sew all the units of two in the same orientation.

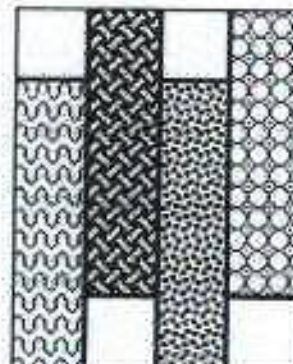
Sew all like this



NOT like this



Join two units of two to make four. Make as many of these blocks as you like.
